



RECRUITMENT ENROLLMENT MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The parties signing below agree to meet joint recruitment/enrollment referral requirements as established in the GSRP Implementation Manual by the Michigan Department of Education and HS Performance Standards by the US Department of Health and Human Services:

GSRP Implementation Manual:

...Participation in a collaborative recruitment and enrollment process to assure that each child is enrolled in the program most appropriate to his or her needs and to maximize the use of federal, state, and local funds.

Head Start Act of 2007, SEC. 642. Powers and Functions of Head Start Agencies. [42 U.S.C. 9837]:

- (2)(A) In communities where both a public prekindergarten program and a Head Start program operate, collaborate and coordinate activities with the local educational agency or other public agency responsible for the operation of the prekindergarten program and providers of prekindergarten, including outreach activities to identify eligible children.
- (B) Collaborate to reduce the duplication and enhance the efficiency of services while increasing the program participation of underserved populations of eligible children; and
- (C) Exchange information on the provision of non-educational services to such children.

We agree to work collaboratively in Wayne County to ensure families receive information to help make informed decisions around program services and eligibility factors for their children.
