Redford Union High School Social Probation Policy

Social probation prohibits students from attending or participating in non-mandatory school functions, activities, and events. Social probation is an alternative to immediate suspension as a means to keep students engaged in the classroom. Redford Union High School will impose social probation for minor infractions including, but not limited to, committing horseplay, chronic absenteeism (more than 10 days), skipping, and tardiness. The consequence scale seen below will be in effect after the first infraction by a student.

Non-mandatory school functions, activities and events include, but are not limited to:

- Athletic practices/game including off-season workouts
- Homecoming Dance and Prom
- Spectating athletic events, plays, concerts, etc.
- Student clubs
- Student Council meetings and events
- Fundraising events
- Marching band
- Senior Night
- Activities related to graduation
- Commencements

Social Probation Consequence Scale

Infraction #	Consequence
1	Verbal Warning & must watch relative Navigate 360 SEL Video
2	Call Home & must watch another relative Navigate 360 SEL Video
3	One Day Social Probation (for next practice or event); Call home
4	Five Days Social Probation (the next five practices or events); Call home
5	Ten Days Social Probation (additionally, a coach/advisor/etc. may consider dismissal from sport, club or activity); Call home
6	Remainder of Semester/School year on Social Probation; Call home
7	Three Days out of school suspension; Call home; Mandatory parent meeting upon return
8	Five Days out of school suspension; Call home; Mandatory parent meeting upon return
9	Referred to Administration

*All out of school suspensions include social probation
